Following the success of 'Art at the Altar 2009', we have been invited to display at Wentworth Castle Gardens over the Easter Bank Holiday weekend. This is a tremendously exciting opportunity for the Hen's Teeth co-operative of Artist and Craftspeople as not only will it broaden our exposure to a wider audience but it will give us the opportunity to produce some new work with something other than Christmas in mind! It will run along similar lines to 'Art at the Altar' and 20% of all sales will be donated to the restoration of Wentworth Castle Gardens.

Opening times

The exhibition will be open daily from 10 am - 5pm. Setting up day is Tuesday 30th March, Preview evening Weds 31st March, We will be open on Thurs, Fri, Sat, Sun, closing Monday at 5pm. Clear up and out by 6pm Monday evening.

Volunteers

We are however dependant on the input of volunteers to run the event so if you would like to display you must give a minimum commitment of 2 sessions towards administering the event. A session will be a morning or an afternoon. One of these sessions must include a session over the bank holiday weekend. If you would like to display but for whatever reason you cannot commit your time to helping out you must team up with an 'Art buddy' from the group who will hopefully be prepared to cover your sessions for you. I'm sure you would return the favour to them at some point. Please indicate your availability on the entry form.

Notes for Exhibitors.

Entry fees for all exhibitors

Exhibitors pay an entry fee of £15. There is no limit to the amount of work you can bring on this occasion but you will be allocated a space depending on how many exhibitors we have.

Proceeds

Delivery

Please bring your exhibition items to Wentworth Castle Gardens at 10am on Tuesday 30th March prompt.

Administration

All entrants must commit to 2 sessions invigilating and helping out on the counter. If you are not able to do these please nominate an, 'Art Buddy'. A session includes one morning or one afternoon (more if possible!). One of these must be over the Bank Holiday Weekend.

Collection

All unsold items of work must be collected at the close of the exhibition at 5 o'clock prompt on Monday 5th April.

Hen's Teeth is an Arts and Crafts co-op and is not supported by any funding. It is run entirely by volunteer helpers and there are no paid employees.

Terms and Conditions of Entry



1. All original art paintings with the exception of canvases must be framed and must have D rings and cord securely tied in readiness for hanging (*no clip frames please!*)
2. **All Work** must be clearly, securely, and individually labelled with your **full name** and **Price**. (*No Initials please!*) Luggage type labels are preferable that hang down **below** the painting when it is displayed.
3. 3D and Craft items should be all individually priced with your **full name** on the reverse of the price tag (again - no initials please) to ensure that we know whose items we are selling.
4. All Art work for display on the walls or on the tables must be original. We do not display digital reproductions of artworks on the walls although there will be baskets available to display window mounted prints and postcards.
5. Art at the Altar committee and administrators reserve the right to refuse to hang works that might be considered inappropriate.
6. All items **must** be the original creation of the entrant and **must** be for sale.
7. Artists wishing to sell cards may only use the central card display. No individual card displays or baskets please.
8. Although Hen's Teeth provide a free wrapping service we would appreciate it if your work requires a lot of bubble wrap if you could endeavor to provide some for use at the pay point table.
9. Entrants will be allocated several tickets to the preview evening on Wed 31st March. Artist may send these out to potentially interested parties including Galleries and other outlets that may be interested in your work as well as your own supporters.

10. Disclaimer

Although the utmost care will be taken with all items **Hen's Teeth, The Committee for 'Art at the Altar' and Wentworth Castle Gardens cannot accept liability should work be damaged, lost or stolen at any time.**

We advise artists who are concerned to take out their own individual insurance. You can rest assured that the best possible care and vigilance is kept at all times.
